Central steel stringer with folded plate tread supports

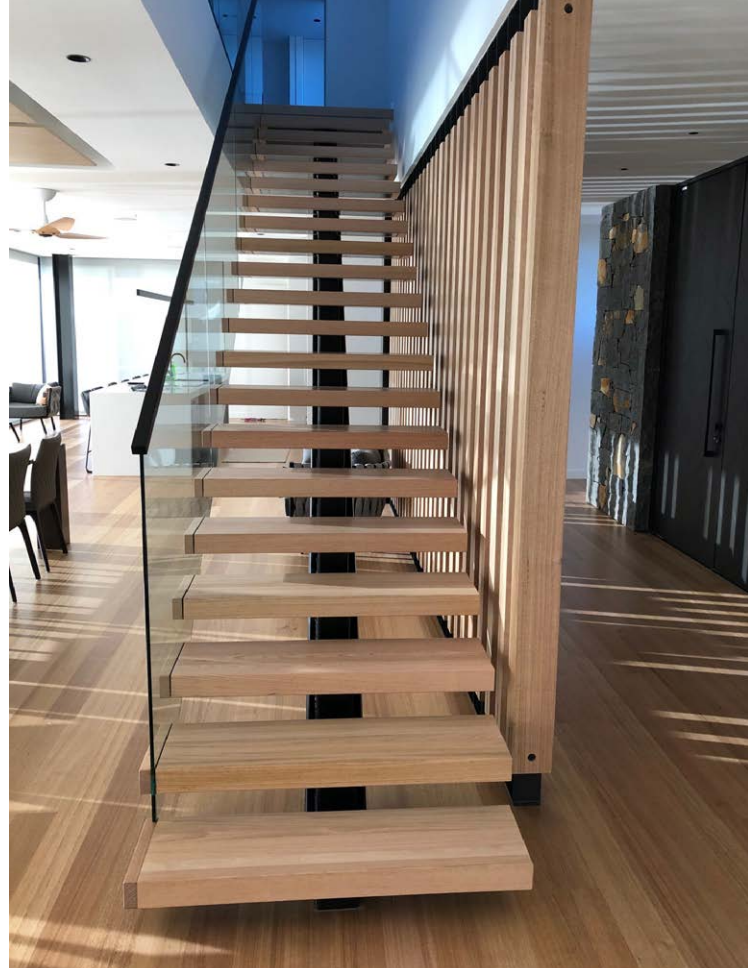

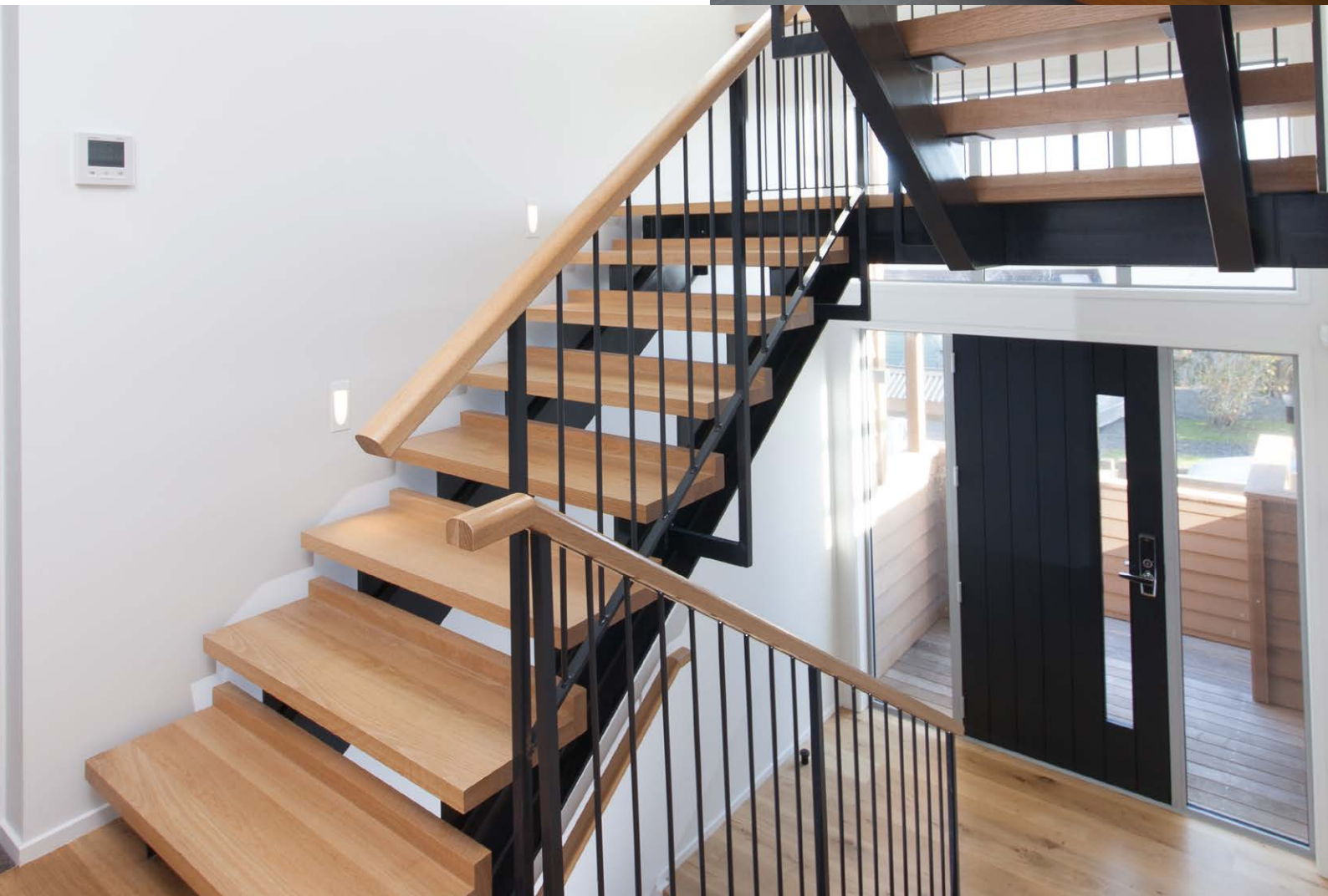

Timber treads and stringers with open risers

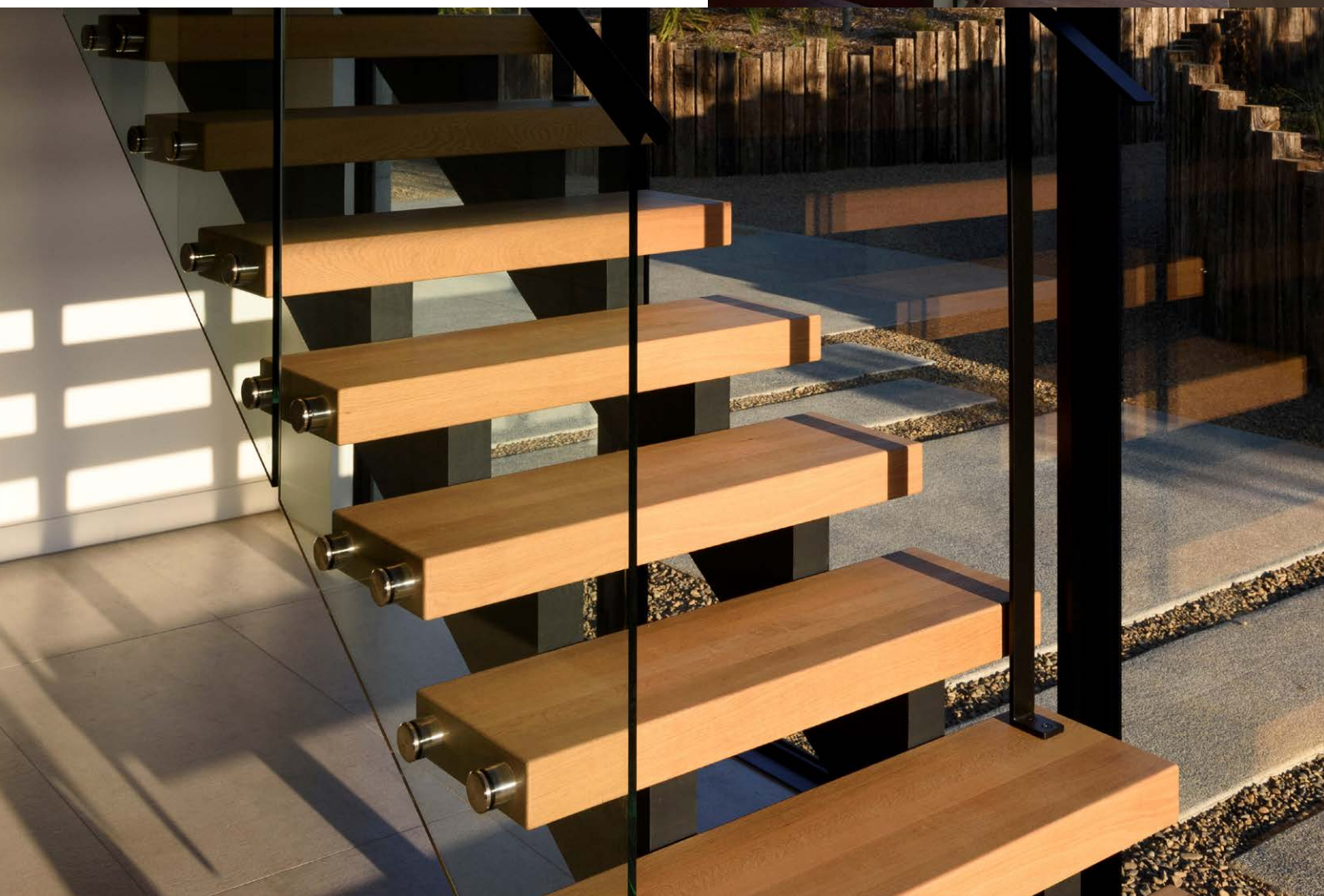
Timber always looks splendid and the open risers of Separare let the light through to brighten the whole stairwell. Separare can be made in the timber of your choice.

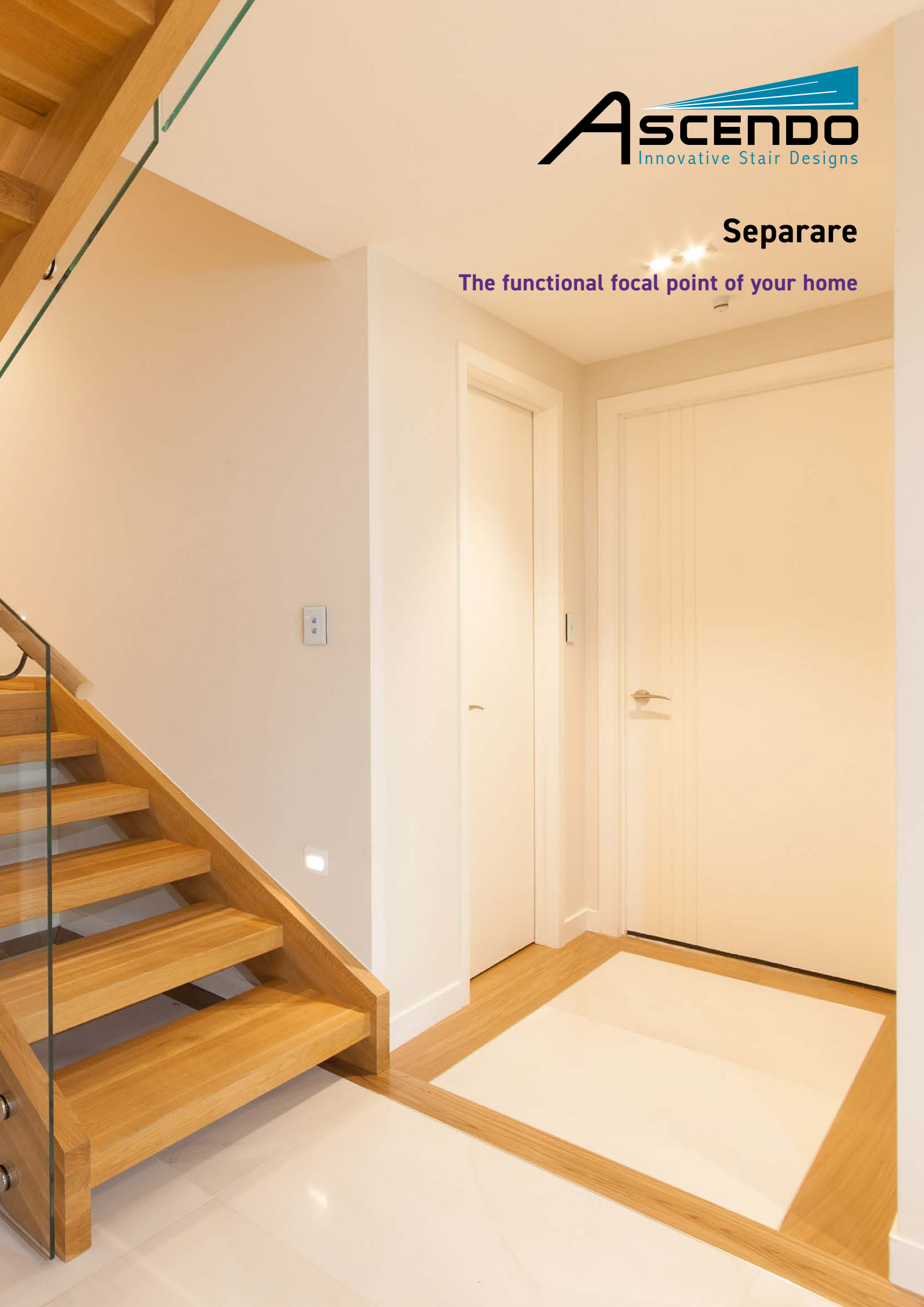

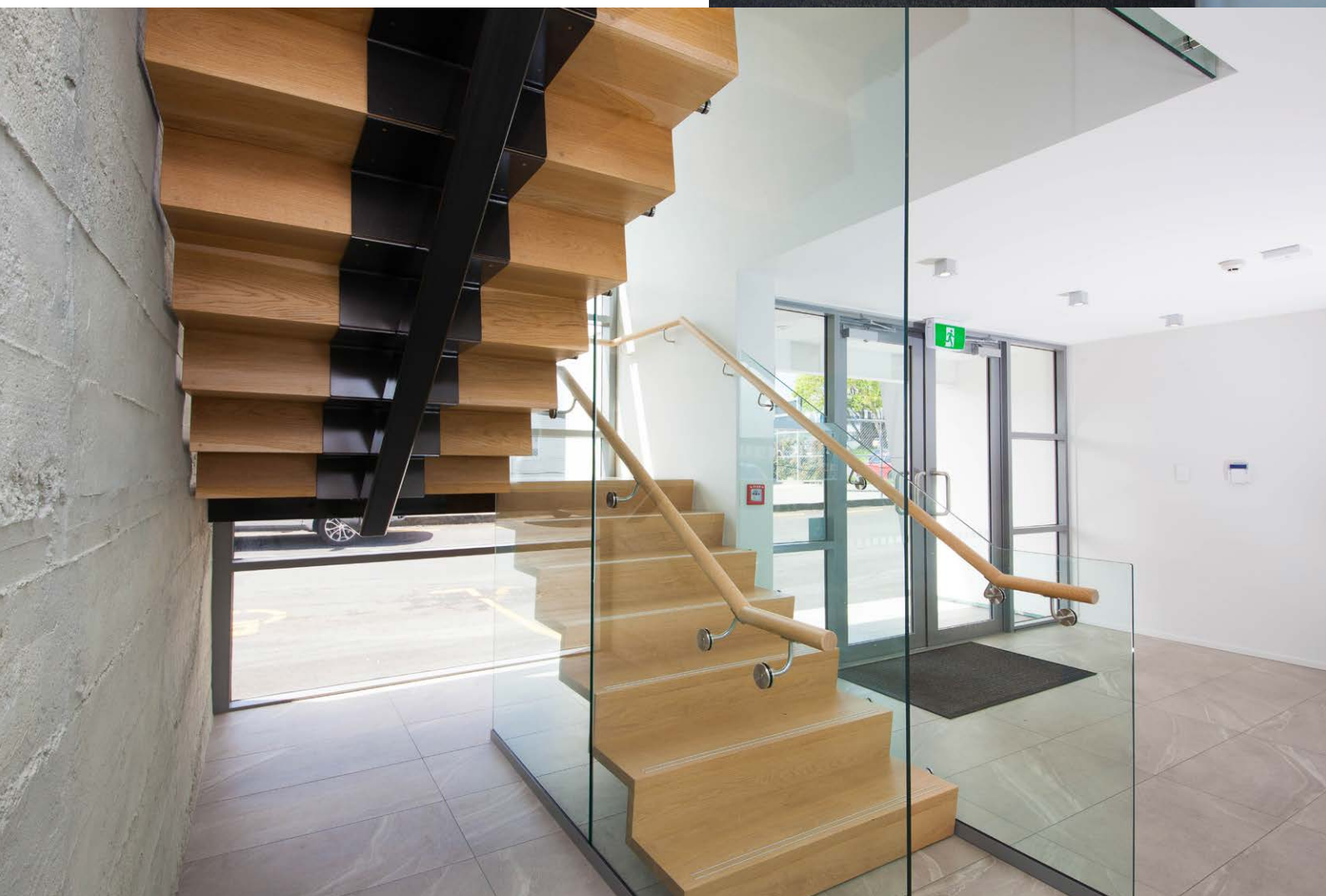

A combination of white paint and dark stained timber creates a beautiful traditional theme.

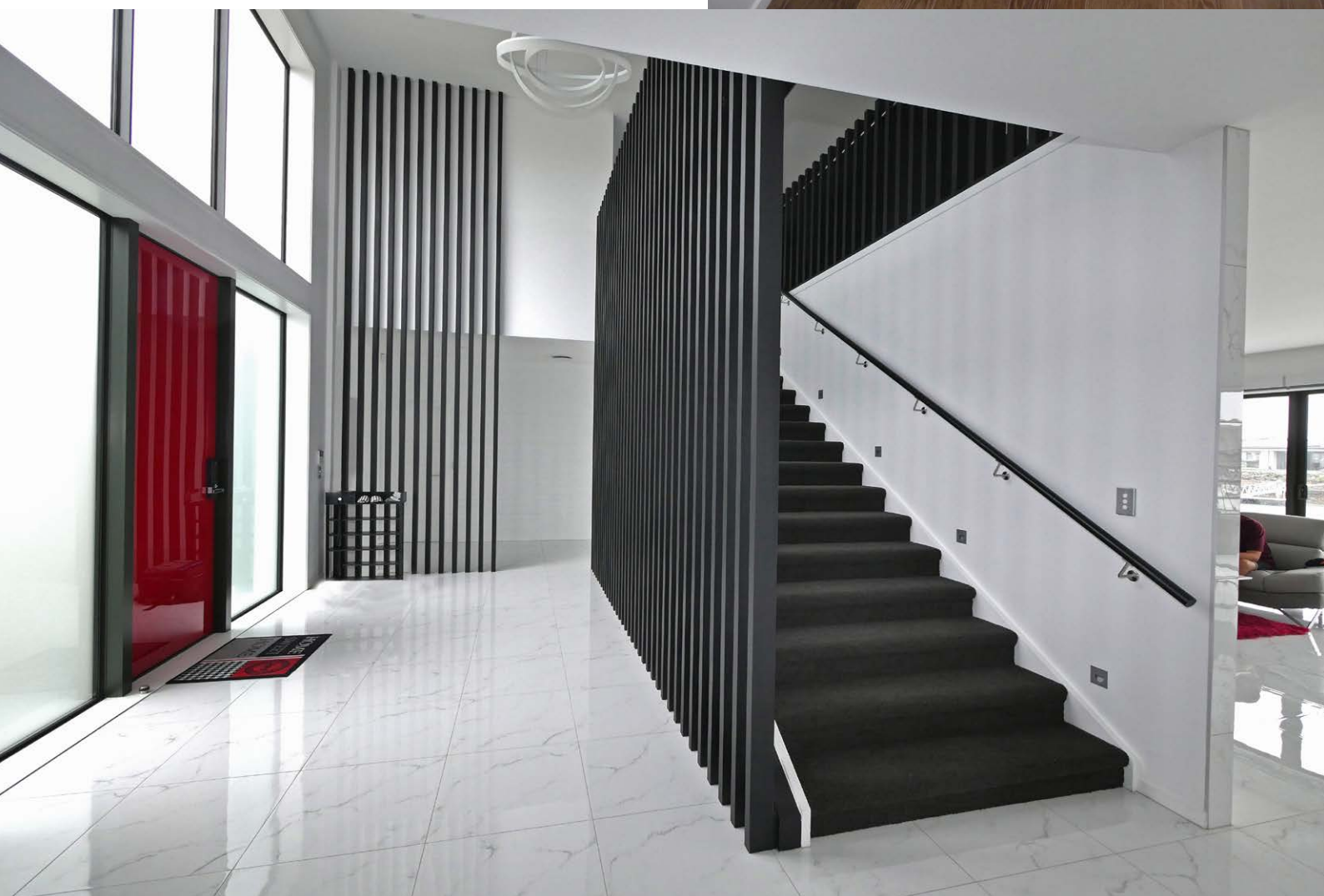
Treads and risers in the timber of your choice with undercut painted stringers provide a simplistic modern style.

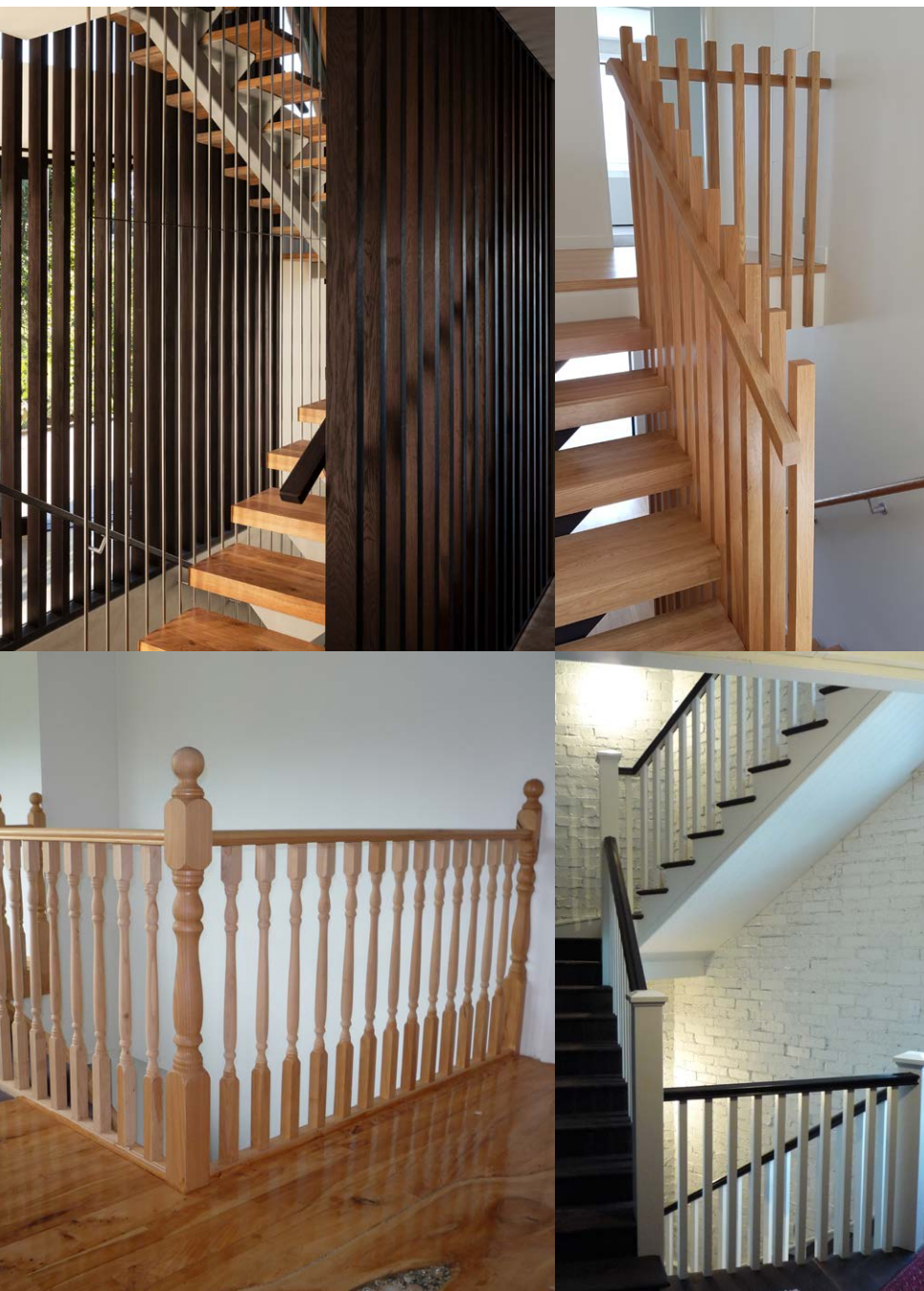

Balustrades

Balustrades are an essential component of any staircase, as they create a barrier to prevent you from falling. But while they play a necessary function, they also add to the aesthetics of the stairwell and your home.

There are many options when it comes to balustrade styles. The three main materials used in stairway balustrades are steel, timber and glass.



Timber fins

A modern twist on a traditional timber balustrade, timber fins offer the warmth of timber tones along with sleek lines for modern appeal.

Traditional timber

The timelessness of a traditional style balustrade is the perfect accompaniment to a solid timber staircase.

Glass

Glass balustrades strike a balance between function and form. Glass has a seamless, minimalist look that blends in perfectly with contemporary interior designs.



Steel rods

With a hint of industrial style, steel rods also create a modern look and help to emphasis your 'floating' staircase.



Wrought iron

Steel can be used to create an ornate, traditional balustrade or keep it simple with flat bars or rods to create a simple, modern style.



Handrails

New Zealand regulations require all staircases to have a handrail on at least one side. Handrails are attached to the wall and in some cases attached to or form part of the balustrade.

Steel and timber are the most common materials used for handrails and they are available in a variety of different profiles.
